

N.Y. Restaurant On Way

...It's a coup for downtown.

Il Mulino, one of the top restaurants in New York, has selected the 191 Peachtree Tower building for its Atlanta restaurant.

Zagat has repeatedly listed Il Mulino in Greenwich Village as New York's top Italian restaurant.

The restaurant will bring new life to Peachtree Street because it will be located in the now-vacant space that used to house the Wachovia bank branch across the lobby from the Ritz-Carlton Atlanta.

This is one more piece of evidence that the decision by Cousins Properties to buy the 191 building and move its own corporate headquarters there is bringing new life to downtown.

"This shows downtown has arrived on the restaurant scene," said A.J. Robinson, president of Central Atlanta Progress.
